LAW RESEARCH ASSISTANT

CIRL is accepting applications for spring/summer legal research assistant positions for the period May through August 2020. Students currently enrolled in the first or second year of a Juris Doctor program are eligible to apply. Candidates must have an interest in environmental and energy law along with excellent research and writing skills. The salary is \$18.00 per hour plus benefits.

To be eligible to apply for this position, students must also:

- Have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment; and,
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Preference will be given to qualified Indigenous students.
